

## Detektivní příběh – pracovní list

Žáci dostanou text rozdělený na jednotlivé strany tak, aby nemohli případně vidět řešení úkolů či odpovídat s dopomocí následujícího kontextu. Jednotlivé strany jsou naznačeny v následujícím textu.

### Pracovní list č. 1: Storybooklet: “Who took the sandwich?”

Mike was very hungry. “I think I’ll make a sandwich,” he said. Mike went to the kitchen and got two slices of sandwich bread. He toasted them until they were brown and placed some chicken and tomato slices. Then he put two pieces of lettuce over the tomatoes. He likes cheese, so he followed with three slices of Swiss cheese. Yummy!

Mike has got a lot of different things in his sandwich. Which is **NOT** true about Mike’s sandwich?

- a. Mike has got some meat.
- b. Mike has got some cheese.
- c. Mike has got vegetables.
- d. Mike has got some mayonnaise.

A)

“Yummy,” said Mike. He licked his lips. Then the doorbell rang.

What do you think will happen next?

- a. Mike will eat the sandwich because he is hungry.
- b. Mike will open the door.
- c. Mike will do his homework first and then eat the sandwich.
- d. Mike will call his mum and tell her that he made the sandwich.

**B)**

Mike went to open the door.

Mike's dog, Rex, walked in the kitchen. He sniffed the sandwich. The sandwich smelled good to Rex, so he licked his lips.

What does Rex want to do?

- a. He wants to run away.
- b. He wants to stay at home and sleep.
- c. He wants to eat the sandwich.
- d. He wants to go to the park and play with Mike.

**C)**

But what about the sandwich? Where is it? Who took it?

- a. Mike took it.
- b. Rex took it.
- c. The person who rang the bell took it.
- d. Nobody took it, but it is GONE!

**Pracovní list č. 2:** Ordering the sentences:

Mike licked his slips.

Somebody rang the doorbell.

Mike was hungry and made a sandwich.

The sandwich was with chicken meat, lettuce and cheese.

Rex went to the kitchen and sniffed the sandwich.

Rex licked his lips.



### **Pracovní list č. 3**

Mike did not train Rex.

Someone rang the doorbell, came to the house and took the sandwich.

Mike made a chicken sandwich. Rex likes chicken sandwiches.

Mike should make another sandwich, but without the meat because Rex loves chicken but not vegetables.
